## Mission Level 1

Families of Deployed Military and DoD Civilians  
Benefits start 30 days before Deployment and end 60 days after return

- 16 hours free Hourly Respite Care per child/month.
- \$2.00 per child Hourly Care rate for any Hourly Care beyond Respite Care hours.
- 20% reduction in fees for regularly scheduled Full Day and Part Day programs (FDC, PDPS, SAS) when the spouse, custodial parent or guardian is employed or a full time student.
- Up to 4 free SKIES classes/child. (May only be enrolled in one free class at a time.)
- Up to 2 free CYS Team or Individual Sports per child.
- Free Childcare during mandatory Deployment meeting.
- Free Childcare during FRG meetings.



## Mission Level 2

Families of Military and DoD Civilians  
serving under the following orders: TCS, PCS  
unaccompanied tour + TDY status for 90 to 179 days.

- 16 hours free Hourly Respite Care per child/month.
- \$2.00 per child Hourly Care rate for any Hourly Care beyond free Respite Care hours.
- Up to 2 free SKIES classes/child. (May be enrolled in one free class at a time.)
- Up to 1 free CYS Team or Individual Sport per child.
- Free Childcare during mandatory Deployment meetings.
- Free Childcare during FRG meetings.

- \$2.00 per child Hourly Care rate for any Hourly Care beyond free Respite Care hours.
- Up to 2 free SKIES classes/child. (May only be enrolled in one free class at a time.)
- Up to 1 free CYS Team or Individual Sport per child.
- Free Childcare during FRG meetings.

## Families of Wounded Warriors

Army Wounded Warriors AW2 and Warriors in Transition WT as identified by the WT Unit Commander

- 16 hours free Hourly Respite Care per child/month during designated eligible period.
- Unlimited free Hourly Care for medical appointments.
- \$2.00 per child Hourly Care rate for any Hourly Care beyond free Respite Care hours.
- Cat 1 fees for regularly scheduled Full Day and Part Day programs (FDC, PDPS, SAS).
- Up to 4 free SKIES classes/child. (May only be enrolled in one free class at a time.)
- Up to 2 free CYS Team or Individual Sport per child.
- Free Childcare during mandatory Deployment meetings.
- Free Childcare during FRG meetings.

## Families of Fallen Warriors

- 16 hours free Hourly Respite Care per child/month during designated eligible period.
- Reduced \$2.00 per child Hourly Care rate for any Hourly Care beyond free Respite Care hours.
- 40 additional free hours of Hourly Care per child for immediate Family of deceased (valid from notification to 4 weeks after burial).
- Cat 1 fees for regularly scheduled Full Day and Part Day programs (FDC, PDPS, SAS).
- Up to 4 free SKIES classes/child. (May only be enrolled in one free class at a time.)
- Up to 2 free CYS Team or Individual Sport per child.

## CYS Extended Services

- CDC Hourly Care opening hours extended until 1800 on Mondays and Wednesdays - Reservations required
- CDC and SAS (Full Day Care and Before and After School) new opening hours 0530-1800
- CDC and SAS open 1830-2030 on Tuesdays - Reservation required
- CDC and SAS open the 1st Saturday of the month from 0900-1300 - Reservation required
